

COUNTY BOY DROWNS IN ABANDONED QUARRY

**Frank Dilworth, Barren Hill, Loses
Life When He Steps from
Ledge**

Frank Dilworth, Jr., seventeen years old, of Barren Hill, lost his life when he stepped from a ledge in the abandoned Cox quarry, near Germantown nike and Flourtown road, Barren Hill, yesterday afternoon.

The drowning victim had been wading in shallow water while two friends, Walter Hodson and Clayton McAdoo, were swimming nearby. Suddenly Dilworth stepped from the ledge and went down in twelve foot of water. He could not swim.

Hodson and McAdoo dived for his body, but could not locate it and finally summoned police who recovered it two hours later.

The boy is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Frank Dilworth and these brothers and sisters: Margaret, William, Helen, Austin and Barbara.
