

Child Drowns In Old Quarry

Farmington—Ola Mae White, aged four years, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Roy White, of Farmington, was accidentally drowned in an abandoned quarry in the northeast part of Farmington about eleven o'clock yesterday morning.

The youngster with two other children were playing near the quarry when the White child apparently slipped and fell in. City Marshal George Mackley and Sid Hammors, who were on patrol duty, came along and were called to the scene of the accident by the two other children. They removed the body from the water and immediately sent for Dr. Watkins. Every effort was made to revive the child, but life apparently was extinct when the doctor arrived.

The body was brought to the Neidert Funeral Home and an inquest was held yesterday afternoon and the verdict was that death was due to accidental drowning.—News.
