

MOTHER STANDS HELPLESS AS YOUNG SON DROWNS

Woodlyn, Pa., Nov. 3. (U.P.)—Mrs. Mary Fulmer stood by helplessly last night and watched her six-year-old son, Daniel, drown in a water-filled quarry.

"I saw him bob to the surface several times, floating about for a short time," she said.

The victim's playmate, John Gray, six, said they were standing at the top of the quarry when Daniel slipped and plunged down the cliff.

Mrs. Fulmer, who lives in a Delaware County trailer camp for war workers, hurried up to the quarry wall and then ran screaming for aid.

The Franklin Rescue Squad of Chester grappled for an hour before they recovered the body.
