



BOY, 12, DROWNS.

DAVENPORT, IA.—No inquest will be held into the death of Ronnie Kelleher, 12, East Moline, Ill., boy who drowned Saturday in an abandoned quarry in west Davenport when a raft on which he was playing collapsed, Coroner Frank C. Keppy announced.

The victim's two playmates, Richard Vizard, 11, and Bobby Vaughn, 8, of Davenport, who also were playing on rafts, witnessed the tragedy but were unable to go to the rescue of their companion.

Ronnie was near the middle of the quarry when his raft collapsed and he plunged into the water. The body was recovered.
