

Elyton man drowns at Ketona quarry

A 21-year-old Elyton man drowned late yesterday in the 200 feet deep waters of Ketona Quarry near Tarrant City.

He was **Eugene May**, of 216 Green Street.

It was the second drowning at Ketona in the past 10 days. **James Lee Davis**, 16, of 2705 23rd Avenue, North, was the other victim.

Highway Patrolman Gordon Griffin said May, like Davis, evidently was unable to swim.

MAY WENT to the old quarry about 2 p.m. with five teen-aged playmates and was playing at the water's edge when he apparently lost his footing.

His body was found nearly two hours later by Chief Paul Gaines of the Tarrant police.

Deputy Coroner J. O. Butler said May grabbed at Thomas Homes, 18, of 818 Third Alley, North, but lost his grip and apparently never came up. May was employed by the Dixie Produce Company.
