their boyfriends was the last youthful escapade for two Toledo sisters today.

Patricia Bronikowski, 20, and her sister Jacqueline, 18, jumped at the chance to cool off when the two Bradner, O. youths called for them. They put on their swimming suits and got in the car.

At the abandoned stone quarry near Fostoria, while the boys were changing into their trunks in the car, the girls disappeared. The boys said they heard no shouts and thought the girls were hiding. When they could find no trace, they became frightened and called the sheriff.

The bodies were recovered in 30 feet of water. The sheriff said the girls had apparently jumped into the quarry without knowing how to swim.
