

Boy, 15, Drowns, Swimming In Abandoned Quarry

BROCKPORT, June 15.—A 15-year-old boy, who had just learned to swim the day before, drowned about 6 o'clock Monday evening while swimming with companions in an abandoned stone quarry near Swamp Rd. and the Sweden-Walker Rd., Town of Sweden.

He was Howard F. Townley of South Lake Rd., RFD, Brockport.

Corp. Thomas E. Nulty of the Batavia State Police Barracks, who investigated and recovered the body, said that Howard was on a raft with some other swimmers when he apparently slipped and fell into the water.
