

Two Cousins Drown In Quarry Waters

HIGH POINT, June 23 (AP)—Two cousins scuffled playfully in the cool waters of an abandoned rock quarry seven miles southeast of here this afternoon and then slipped off an innertube to their deaths.

The cousins were identified as Freemont Hensley, 20, of High Point and Dayton Hensley, 24, of Rt. 5, High Point.

Swimmers in other sections of the quarry attempted to rescue the pair but were unsuccessful. The quarry has a depth of 80 feet in some spots.

The Guil-Rand Fire Dept. Rescue Squad recovered the body of Freemont about 5:30 p.m. and the High Point Rescue Squad found the body of Dayton about 6:30 p.m. Both were recovered in about 15 feet of water.
