The Good Wills furnished ropes and graping hooks for locating the body and the Friendships furnished the resuscitator which was used in an attempt to revive the youth.

Richard E. Cline, 227 South Wash ington street, Greencastle, an amateur diver, plunged into the water with "skin diving" equipment including oxygen tanks and a face mask. He located the body on a ledge 15 feet under the surface and tied a rope around the drowned youth's leg so that firemen could pull him to the surface.
