

YOUTH LOSES LIFE LEARNING TO SWIM

**Drowns In Quarry After Trying
To Grip Bank Of Hole**

Franklin, June 14 (UPI)—Robert Holsten, 19, drowned Monday when he lost his grip on the bank of a swimming hole while trying to learn how to swim.

Police said Holsten, of 1113 Summit Avenue, Union City, a non-swimmer, went into 30-foot water with two friends who were to help him learn to swim.

The youth apparently lost his hold and went under, police said. His body was recovered 2 hours later.

The accident occurred at Windsor Quarry, a former limestone quarry converted to a swimming hole, in nearby Hardyston Township.
