

# Father, Two Sons Drown In Quarry

MOUNT GILEAD, Ohio (UPI)—  
A father and his two young boys  
drowned Saturday night in an  
abandoned and condemned water-  
filled stone quarry near here.

One of the boys slipped in and  
the father leaped in to save him.  
The second boy jumped in to  
save both of them.

The tragedy occurred at a pop-  
ular fishing and swimming quar-  
ry about five miles south of here.  
The quarry had been declared off-  
limits to the public by the sheiff  
years ago.

Recovery workers had to carry  
a rescue boat through a dense  
field to recover the bodies of  
Carman E. Edwards, about 38, a  
factory worker from nearby Car-  
dington R.D. 3, and his two sons,  
Bryan 11, and Raymond, 10.

Edwards' wife, Mildred and two  
other children, Daniel, 6, and Don-  
na, 4, witnessed the accident. The  
woman was taken to a hospital  
for treatment for shock.

The family had been fishing.
