Two Wisconsin Youths Drown

Two high school boys drowned Tuesday in Waukesha County waters.

Richard Kinjerske, 16, Milwaukee, drowned in Upper Kelly Lake on the Waukesha-Milwaukee county line, and Charles Schmidt, 17, of Brookfield, in a stone quarry in the village of Sussex. Both bodies were recovered.

The Kinjerske boy went under while swimming with a companion to a raft about 50 feet from shore.

The Schmidt youth and four friends were swimming at the quarry when authorities told them to leave. The quarry is behind a canning firm. Two of the group walked around the quarry to their car while Schmidt and another youth decided to swim across. Schmidt went down.
