

TWO BROTHERS DROWN IN RESCUE ATTEMPT

Kakankee, April 1 (AP)

Two boys drowned today in an abandoned limestone quarry as they attempted to save a playmate.

James Fiffer, 11, and his brother John, 10, jumped into the 20-by-50-foot pond to save Monroe Galliday Jr., 9, who had fallen in. The Fiffer brothers drowned as Galliday reached the bank safely.

Authorities said the boys drowned in 5 feet of water.
