# Drownings Top Traffic Fatalities

Traffic deaths during the hot July weekend just ended took a sharp drop compared to the previous weekend, but drownings intervened to give Ohio a substantial accidental death toll.

In the period from 6 p.m. Friday to Sunday midnight, six deaths had been counted on the highways. Seven drownings were reported and two persons died in miscellaneous accidents for an overall count of 15.

This compared to 22 traffic deaths the previous weekend when three drownings and two miscellaneous fatalities pushed the toll to 27.

**Friday Night**

James White, 14 Cleveland,

struck by a car while riding his bicycle in Cleveland.

**Saturday**

Elmerm Hayes Latham Jr., thrown from his motorcycle in a traffic accident in Lima.

Jack Trippett, 31, Columbus, died Saturday of injuries received Friday night when his auto hit a tree.

Mrs. Carrabelle Swartzbaugh, 57, Cleveland, struck by a car as she got out of her own car in Cleveland.

Mrs. Marie Sheldon, 36, Columbus, in a fire at her home.

**Sunday**

Kelly Goss, 2, son of Mr. and Mrs. William Goss, Lima, of burns and smoke inhalation in a fire at the family home.

Jeannine Argabright, 3, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jerry Argabright, Piqua, drowned in a wading pool at her home.

Walter J. Zylowski, 47, Euclid, drowned at Cleveland's

east side beach after going swimming.

John G. Kline Jr., 13, of Bolivar (Tuscarawas County) drowned after going swimming at Shepler Beach near Canton.

Mrs. Leonard Schmidt, Greensburg, in a two-car crash near New Philadelphia.

Louis Bausch, 17, Columbus, **drowned in an abandoned quarry** after going swimming with his brother and a companion.

Terry King, 5, Cleveland, drowned after wandering into Midway Lake near Orwell.

Greg Woods, 17, Ottawa, **drowned after going swimming in a quarry** near Cloverdale in Putnam County.

Nick Sherban, 49, Louisville, Ohio, died in two-car crash on rural road in northeastern Tuscarawas County.

Thelma Oweng, 13, Portsmouth, drowned while swimming at mouth of Scioto River.
