

3 Children Nearly Drown In Old Quarry

Three children were rescued from a water-filled abandoned quarry at the end of Ruby Drive in Aberdeen on Sunday evening.

Returned safely to their 428 Doris Circle home in Aberdeen after the 6:40 p. m. accident were 6-year-old Virginia Columnna and her two little brothers, Arthur and Charles, about 11 years.

The children had been picking berries along an embankment, when they slid into the quarry, which is filled with about six feet of water. Mr. Robert Balcey and Maj. Shackelford, who live nearby, rushed to the scene, dove in and rescued them.
