

# FIREMEN AID TRAPPED BOY

NORTH ADAMS, Mass. (AP)  
— Two firemen lowered themselves 100 feet on a rope to rescue Daniel Pollock, 11, who had climbed high up the side of an abandoned quarry and then couldn't get down.

Firemen Elmer Potter and William Garner climbed down a rope from the top of the 175-foot ledge, then tied another rope around the boy's waist and lowered him to rescuers waiting below.

Daniel and a companion, Wayne MacDonald, 9, Sunday had crawled up Witt's Ledge, an abandoned limestone quarry. Wayne got down but his friend could not get firm footing to descend and remained on a ledge, clinging to a slim birch tree.
