Boy drowns

CONOWINGO, Md.—A 15-yearold Baltimore boy drowned last night in an abandoned quarry near where he and two companions had gone camping.

Maryland State Police identified the dead boy as Francis Joseph Calligan, 15, of Baltimore.

Police said Calligan and two companions, Richard Gerald Sobsczak, 16, and Raymond David, 14, both of Baltimore, had pitched their tents near the quarry off Red Hill Road about 3 miles north of Conowingo, and about 6 p.m. yesterday they started to swim across the quarry.

Halfway across, police said, the Calligan boy apparently panicked. The two other boys went to his aid, but he pulled them under.

They broke away, swam to the bank and threw Calligan a board. He sank clutching at the board, the boys said. The boys went to a nearby residence to summon help and about 7:45 last night, scuba divers recovered the body.

Calligan was pronounced dead at the scene.
