

Glenshaw Youth Drowns at Mine

A 17-year-old Glenshaw youth drowned yesterday while swimming in a water-filled abandoned strip mine about 11 miles northwest of Butler.

The dead youth was Charles Edick, of 1492 Elm Ave.

State Police at Butler said Charles was in a group of about 10 boys and girls picnicking and swimming at the no-longer-used Chutz Mine Quarry near Route 8 about three miles from Unionville.

Swimming is prohibited there, but the water area is unfenced. “
