

Girl, 15, Drowns In Quarry

MOREHEAD, Ky.—A 15-year-old high school girl swimming with a group of students from Morehead State University drowned at 12:30 p.m. Sunday in an abandoned stone quarry about six miles from here.

Pronounced dead on arrival at the St. Clair Medical Center was Miss Linda Lou Ginter, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Tom Ginter of Clearfield. She attended Rowan County High School.

Other survivors are eight brothers, Earl Jr., Freddie, Teddy and Jesse Ginter, Clearfield; Charlie Ginter, Las Vegas, Nev.; Ralph and Glenn Ginter, Middletown, Ohio, and Ernie Ginter, Lavonia, Mich., and two sisters, Mrs. Mary McKinney, Middletown, Ohio, and Miss Alpha Mae Ginter, Clearfield.

Services will be conducted at 2 p.m. today at the Farmers Church of God by the Rev. Ott Flannery and the Rev. David Dehner. Burial will be in the Clearfield Cemetery. The body is at the Stucky Funeral Home.
