

## Lindseyville Youth Drowns In Quarry

BROWNSVILLE, Ky. — Nathan Leon Duvall, 18, a student from Lindseyville, drowned at 6:30 p.m. Tuesday while swimming in an abandoned rock quarry near Sweeden.

Duvall's swimming companion, Steve Jagers, also of Lindseyville, was admitted to City-County Hospital in Bowling Green after running to seek help. He was released from the hospital this morning.

Edmonson County Coroner Don Sharer ruled the death accidental. The body was recovered from the quarry by the Brownsville Rescue Squad at about 11:30 p.m. The quarry is eight to 10 miles north of Brownsville.

Funeral services for Duvall are scheduled for 1 p.m. Friday at the Midway Baptist Church, Lindseyville. Burial will be in the church cemetery.

Survivors include his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Charlie Duvall, Lindseyville; two brothers, Trent Duvall, of Louisville, and Charles Duvall, Brownsville; three sisters, Mrs. Goldie Spainhoward, Hartford, Mrs. Nellie Mings, Louisville, and Mrs. Linda Hogan, of Brownsville.

The body is at Sharer Funeral Home.
