

# INVESTIGATION ORDERED.

## FRATERVILLE MINE EXPLOSION TO BE LOOKED INTO.

Clinton, Tenn., May 30.—A special dispatch from here to the Knoxville Sentinel, says that Judge W. R. Hicks has instructed the circuit court grand jury of Anderson county to investigate the cause of the Fraterville mine explosion of May 19 at Coal Creek, in which 216 men and boys lost their lives.

Maj. E. C. Camp and Geo. Camp, president and superintendent respectfully, of the Coal Creek Coal Company, State Mine Inspector R. A. Shifflett and the men who went with him on the official inspection last Monday and members of the first rescuing party to enter the mine have been subpoenaed to appear before the grand jury.
