

## FRATERVILLE MINE DISASTER.

### Grand Jury of Anderson County Will Investigate Cause.

Knoxville, Tenn., May 30.—A special to The Sentinel from Clinton, Tenn., says:

Judge W. R. Hicks has instructed the circuit court grand jury of Anderson county to investigate the cause of the Fraterville mine explosion of May 19 at Coal Creek, in which 216 men and boys lost their lives. Major E. C. Camp and George Camp, president, and State Mine Inspector R. A. Shifflet and the men who went with him on the official inspection last Monday and members of the first rescuing party to enter the mine, have been subpoenaed to appear before the grand jury.
