Coal Creek, Tenn., June 24.—The coroner's jury which investigated the Fraterville mine explosion of May 19 finds that the men and boys in the mine "came to their death from an explosion in said mine, which explosion was caused by gas or coal dust, or both combined, and further agree that said explosion was caused by neglect of the mine officers and state mine inspector."
