FIFTEEN STILL MISSING.

Believed to Be in Shaft Parral Mine-Eleven Taken Out Alive.

Thurmond, W. Va., Feb. 9,-Fifteen miners were still missing tonight, and are believed to be in the shaft of the Parral mine where an explosion occurred yesterday. Eleven have been taken out alive and six dead.

Ike Speers, colored machine man, was found with his mouth against an air hole, evidently trying to get The other five were found air. about 175 feet from the mine opening, their bodies being severely burned.

A rescuing party composed of experienced mine experts in charge of Mine Inspector Pinkney expects to reach the missing miners before morning.

The mine stage was kept running after the accident, and the work of rescuing the imprisoned miners gan immediately. Morley Pratt. bank boss, and his sons are among the dead. Their bodies are still in the mine.
