

Death List as Result of Explosion Will Reach Over Twenty.

HINTON, W. Va., Feb. 9.—It is now practically settled that there were thirty-one men in the Parral mine, near Oak Hill, Fayette County, when the explosion occurred there yesterday afternoon. Eleven were rescued, six bodies have been recovered and fourteen bodies are in the mine. Some of the rescued are badly injured and two will probably die.

Robert Gill, who was rescued, has both legs broken and Donald Bell is badly crushed.
