

LAW WAS VIOLATED; INSPECTOR KNEW IT

Coroner's Jury Returns Two Hundred
and Fifty Separate Verdicts, in
the Cherry Mine Disaster
Investigation.

Chicago, May 19.—The coroner's jury, appointed last November to investigate the Cherry mine horror, in which 265 men lost their lives, returned 250 separate verdicts today. The jury declared that the laws relative to means of escape, were violated with the knowledge and consent of the mine inspector of the district. The fire was caused by contact of an open torch with a load of hay.
