

## DEATH LIST CON- TINUES TO GROW

VICTIMS OF LAYLAND MINE  
EXPLOSION BEING RE-  
MOVED AS FAST AS  
POSSIBLE

from Last Friday's Daily Issue.

The death list of the Layland mine explosion continues to grow as the victims are recovered and prepared for their second burial, for such it is. It is a conservative estimate to say that at least 165 persons perished by the explosion. Thirty-one of the dead have been brought to this city, some of whom—those of Foreign birth—are being buried here.

Nine have been shipped to Springdale for burial. They are as follows:

Allen, T., F. E., Frances, I. C. and J. A. Fitzpatrick, Martin Lynch, Dennis S. Hurley and John Farry.

The following nine are to be buried at Scarbro: A. C. Leonard, John Thomas and Wm. Branden, Wm. Henry Bryant, Boland Herbert, Barrett James, John Jos. Blaker, Burdiers Henry and John D. Billmyer.

Twelve more will arrive here tomorrow on No. 14. Funeral services, in memory of the departed miners, will be conducted in St. Patrick's church tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock.
