

PROBE MINE DISASTER

Survivors of Layland Explosion Will Testify at Inquest.

HINTON, W. Va., March 17. — The inquest into the deaths of 109 miners who perished in the Layland mines of the New River and Pocahontas Coal company, two weeks ago, was begun here today and at the same time State Mine Inspector Earl Henry began an investigation for his department. The inquest will take a week or more. The survivors of the disaster will be among the witnesses.
