

RESCUERS ORDERED TO LEAVE MINE 150 FEET FROM VICTIMS

State Mine Inspector at Amsterdam Mine Feared an Explosion

Steubenville, Ohio, Oct. 30.—After battling their way to within 150 feet of where twenty miners have been imprisoned since yesterday morning, the rescue workers were ordered out of the Y. and O. coal mine at Amsterdam, Ohio, at six o'clock this morning by the mine officials and the state mine inspectors, who feared an explosion might occur, according to word received here. Hope has been abandoned that the miners are alive.
