

Mine Accident Victim Is Buried At Sayreton

Funeral services for Michael Loebler, 73, of Sayreton, who was killed in a mine accident yesterday, were held today at the Sayreton Assembly of God Church.

Mr. Loebler was killed instantly when struck by a "man trip" being lowered in a Republic Steel Corporation mine to bring up the night shift workers, company officials said.

Employed as a pumpman, Mr. Loebler apparently was crossing the slope when struck by the descending "trip," or string of cars. The body was dragged about 47 feet, officials said.

Surviving is the widow; a son, Michael Loebler, Jr., foreman at the mines; three grandsons and two granddaughters.

Burial was in New Walker Chapel Cemetery, Brown-Service, Norwood, directing.
