Two Miners Killed In Week-End Mishaps

Two district miners were killed in week-end accidents.

James G. Blasiole, 25, of Clyde No. 2, a veteran of World War II, was crushed to death by a mine motor at 2:45 a.m. Saturday at the Clyde No. 2 mine of Republic Steel Corp., and Frank Federoff, 33, of Moore avenue, Canonsburg, died at 11:35 p.m. Saturday in St. Francis Hospital, Pittsburgh, of injuries suffered Friday when caught between mine cars in the Muse mine.

A third industrial accident resulted in the death in Allegheny Valley Hospital yesterday of James Meighan, 40, Waynesburg, a crane operator. Meighan was injured when a crane collapsed as he was repairing it for the Peoples Natural Gas Company at Apollo, Pa.
