

A Bodie Disaster—Nine Men Fatally Injured.

BODIE, Oct. 4.—As the 6 o'clock shift was being made in the Tioga mine last evening with nine men on board, the engine escaped from the control of the engineer, and the cage went down to the 500-foot level. One man was killed outright, and all are injured in such a manner as to warrant the belief that they will not recover. The names of the men injured by the accident at the Tioga mine are: Thos. Moran, slightly; John Cassidy, both legs broken; Pat Bannon, dying—mashed to pieces; Sam Marston, both legs broken—dying; — French, both legs broken; Manuel Alvaras, injured internally; Harry Richards, killed; Joe Rodock, injured seriously; Pete Pluff, one leg broken. Miner's Union Hall is a place of mourning again, and bears a resemblance to the time of the Standard explosion.
