DENVER, March 17.—The *Republican's* Leadville special says: The news was received of a disastrous snowslide at Carey, a small mining camp in Conundrum Gulch, seventy miles north of here, in which five miners were killed. Their names are J. F. Late, Millard Thorn, S. E. Steele, George Morris, J. P. Steele. The avalanche was several hundred feet wide and fifty feet deep.
