

The Greenback Mine Victims.

SHAMOKIN, Aug. 26.—The coroner to-day began an inquest into the deaths of the eight miners killed at the Greenback colliery last week, while fighting fire in the Buck Ridge mine. The hearing will take several days. Meanwhile the widows of several married men and their 35 children have been made beneficiaries of the Philadelphia and Reading relief fund. Provisions will be made and employment found for the children. The fire is still raging and is thought to be located, but the result of the work now going on to extinguish it cannot be ascertained for weeks.
