

The Youngstown Victims Buried.

UNIONTOWN, October 29.—The men killed in the explosion at the Youngstown mine on Monday evening were buried to-day. Four of the bodies were taken away for burial among friends—one to West Virginia and the other three to different points near here. The remaining ten were interred in the Little Mt. Calvary Cemetery, about a quarter of a mile from the works. These ten bodies were all placed side by side in the church near the works and the Methodist Protestant missionary for the coke region preached one sermon for all, after which they were carried out and buried, all ten at the same time. Everything about the Youngstown mine was very quiet to-day, as all work was suspended. The superintendent says it will take at least two weeks to get the mine in shape again.
