## BULL DOMINGO MINE EXPLOSION.

## The Coroner's Jury Severely Censures the Superintendent.

SILVER CLIFF, Col., November 21.

The coroner's investigation into the cause of the Bull Domingo Mine explosion resulted as follows: The search for the direct cause was thorough, though strenuous efforts were made to excuse the company and superintendent. The jury found, "That the deceased came to their deaths by reason of the criminal negligence of H. W. Foss, superintendent of the mine, in failing to find means for the prevention of said fire, and criminal negligence of said Foss in failing to provide means of exit from the mine."

Foss was arrested and held in \$2,000 bail.
