

THE KETTLE CREEK MINE DISASTER.

LOCK HAVEN, Pa., Nov. 5.—An inquest was held by the coroner of this county on the bodies of the seventeen victims of the Kettle Creek mine explosion. The testimony of witnesses shows that dynamite caused the explosion, but no blame attaches to any one except the miners themselves. The scene at the mine was heartrending when the coroner and the jury reached the place. The mines were but recently opened, and are located in a desolate spot near the town of Benovo. Several of the bodies will be buried there to-day and others will be sent to different points for interment.
