

THE ENTOMBED MINER RESCUED.

MOUNT CARMEL, Penn., March 16.—Peter Nearshalsky, after 50 hours of imprisonment in the Black Diamond Colliery, was hoisted to the surface at 4 o'clock this afternoon. His appearance was the signal for cheers. He had been half buried and had given up all hope when his rescuers reached the "breast" in which he was imprisoned. Strange to say, his injuries, aside from his nervous prostration, are not serious.

After the five men were taken out alive last night it was supposed that Nearshalsky was dead, but the search was continued with the result stated above.
