

DETROIT, Sept. 30.—A special from Bessemer, Mich., says: "A cavein occurred at the East Norrie mine at Ironwood this morning. Ten men are entombed and it is impossible to tell whether they can be rescued alive. The mine is surrounded by weeping and frantic women and relatives, and the scenes are pitiful. Hundreds of men are working to rescue their companions. The company is driving pipes to get air to the men. If the water in the mine does not rise and drown the men they may be rescued. Voices can be heard at intervals."
