

MINER BURIED ALIVE.

He Was Entombed Thirty-One Hours and Did Not Die.

RICH HILL, Mo., Dec. 13.—Dick Tones, the last of the three men entombed in mine No. 15 of the Rich Hill Coal Company by Wednesday's explosion, was found yesterday afternoon and was alive, although he had been buried for thirty-one hours. He was half a mile from the mouth of the mine. He was unconscious when brought to the surface.
