

BOY LOST IN A MINE.

Pennsylvania Lad Rescued After Wandering Around Four Days Without Food or Drink.

Shamokin, Pa., Feb. 19.—After wandering around the dark underground chambers of the Reliance mine since last Monday, Willie Majorisik, aged 11 years, was rescued to-day, in an exhausted condition, by a party of miners. The boy had been without food, drink or light. Majorisik entered the mine with two companions by way of an old drift, but he got separated from them while stopping to light his lamp. He failed to get a light and wandered about seeking an exit until he dropped in exhaustion.
