

BODIES NOT YET REACHED.

Kaska William Colliery Accident a Bad One in Every Way.

Five weeks have passed since the accident at the Kaska William colliery, but none of the bodies have been reached, although the company are working day and night on three shifts cleaning up. Everything under ground is a total wreck. It will take several months to clean up and pump the water out of the underground slope, after getting the pumps at work, and those are still on top of the shaft. As the slope is not filled with water the men are timbering and relaying the road to the water. A great deal of danger is connected with this work, as the men are compelled to use safety lamps, owing to gases and damp. Kaska William is a forlorn looking mining patch since the accident. A great many families have sought other fields of labor and others are seeking employment at Silver Creek in preference to working in this dangerous mine.
