

THIRD BODY RECOVERED.

Rescuers Constantly Working in Flooded Kaska William Colliery.

Pottsville, July 31.—Some ten weeks ago six miners were drowned at Kaska William colliery by a body of water bursting in on them from an abandoned working. Four of them were Slavonians, and thus far three bodies have been recovered, the third, that of Michael Molochif, being reached to-day.

There is still one body lying outside the rock tunnel, besides the bodies of two Americans, Loader Boss Morgan and Pumpsman Deed, which lie at the bottom of the slope with 160 feet of water and debris above them. Though these eight shifts are constantly at work in the rescue, it will be early fall before the bodies in the slope can be removed.

The body removed to-day was in a bad state of decomposition.
