

BRAZNELL MINE HORROR.

**The Death List Will Not Reach Fifty, as
at First Thought—Bodies Are
Terribly Mutilated.**

Brownsville, Pa., Dec. 26.—The search for the dead was kept up at the Braznell mine all night, resulting in the finding of five more bodies, making 20 victims of the explosion. The bodies were so mutilated they have not been identified. A thorough search of the mine was made, but no more bodies were found and it is now believed that the number of dead will not be increased. The work of removing the mass of wreckage in the mine began to-day and a careful search was made for more bodies, although the company's officials feel confident that all the men have been accounted for.
