

## MINE SHAFT BURNED.

### 200 Men Rescued Through Levels of Adjoining Colliery

Butte, Mont., August 9—The shaft house of the Parrott mine was destroyed by fire yesterday, entailing a loss of \$100,000, with insurance of about \$30,000.

The mine is 1 600 feet deep and 200 men were underground. They were rescued through the levels of an adjoining mine. The shaft, it is feared, was badly damaged, although this cannot be learned definitely for a day or two.

The property is owned by the Parrott Copper and Silver Mining Company, which is one of the corporations controlled by the Amalgamated Copper Company.
