

MINERS SAVED.

Elsewhere in the **HERALD** to-day, we speak of thirteen negro miners having been caught in the coal mine of the Alabama-Bryce Insane Hospital, at Tuskalooosa.

Ten of the number were saved, only three succumbing to the awful plight they were in. For sixty-three hours, there was unceasing labor at the mine, pumping the water out and pumping fresh air in, with hopes of saving some of the men, if not all, and it later proved that the fresh air which was supplied them, is what did save the ten. This is one of the most miraculous escapes ever recorded in Alabama.
