Stephen Casper, a miner who was entombed in a counter by a heavy fall of coal and rock at Packer No. 5 colliery, Girardville, Friday morning, was rescued after much difficulty late that night. Although uninjured, he was badly frightened, and after dragging himself through the small entrance knelt and kissed the hands of the men who saved his life. This is the second time that Casper has experienced this ordeal, he having been entombed in a similar manner while working in a mine near Wilkes-Barre several years ago.
