Entombed Miners Rescued.

Shamokin, Pa., July 8.—Eighteen miners were entombed by a gangway caving in at the Reading Coal and Iron Company's Big Mountain colliery last night. A rescuing party drove a hole into the mine through an old slope and to-day reached the miners, who were all alive and uninjured.

Some of them narrowly escaped death in rushing from the falling coal.
