

Wilkesbarre, Pa.—The bodies of nine of the ten miners, who were killed at the Auchincloss colliery in Nanticoke Wednesday, were removed from the shaft Thursday. They were all horribly crushed and mangled by the fall, some 1,800 feet, and identification is difficult. The work of recovery was exceedingly difficult and the rescuers braved extreme danger in securing the bodies. Fifty feet of water filled the sump and it was necessary to install pumps and reduce the water level before any of the bodies could be recovered.
