

COAL MINER BURIED 12 HOURS.

Caught Under Cave-In and Is Rescued by Comrades.

Shenandoah, Pa., Oct. 1.—While Frank Borjerko, an old miner, was digging coal for his family's winter supply in an abandoned drift at the Furnace colliery here the roof caved in, completely covering him. Fellow coal pickers, at the risk of their own lives, set to work and soon uncovered the victim's head, so that he could breathe. For twelve hours they worked like Trojans, despite another threatened fall, and finally dug the victim out alive. He is seriously injured about the body and limbs.
